Description and technical parameters of the 'Aggteleki Nemzeti Park' collector coins

In order to promote the role of these collector coins to transfer value and educate as widely as possible, the silver coin 'Aggteleki Nemzeti Park' will be available for purchase for three months, while stocks last, and the non-ferrous metal version for one year from the date of issuance, at face value in the webshop (https://www.penzvero.hu/) and coin shop of the Hungarian Mint Ltd. (Budapest, distr. V, 7 Báthory street), starting from 23 April 2025.

The main motif of the **obverse** depicts the Aggtelek National Park's heraldic animal, the fire salamander, featured in its natural habitat. In an upper legend on the right is the inscription 'FOLTOS SZALAMANDRA' ('FIRE SALAMANDER'). The edge of the obverse bears the inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' ('HUNGARY'). Below it, aligned to the left in three lines, the denominations '20000' and '3000' as well as the lettering 'FORINT', the mint mark 'BP.' are seen along with the minting year '2025'.

Non-ferrous metal collector coin

The **reverse of the collector coins** depicts a landscape capturing the karstic characteristics of the Aggtelek National Park, which features the Onosma tornense flower, considered to be one of the 100 rarest protected plant species in Europe. The left edge of the reverse bears the inscription 'AGGTELEKI NEMZETI PARK' ('AGGTELEK NATIONAL PARK'), and below it to the left is the inscription 'TORNAI VÉRTŐ' ('ONOSMA TORNENSE'). The designer's mark of industrial artist Boglárka Imrei is placed in the bottom right corner on the reverse.

The collector coin with a face value of HUF 20,000 is struck in .925 fine silver and weighs 31.46 grams. The non-ferrous metal coin is made from an alloy of copper (75%) and nickel (25%) and weighs 27 grams. Both versions are identical in size: $39.6 \times 26.4 \text{ mm}$ flat rectangle with smooth edges. The mintage limit of both coins is 5,000. The silver coin is produced in proof finish and the non-ferrous metal coin in BU finish.
