Preliminary statistical balance sheet of the MNB March 2003

According to the preliminary balance sheet data, the value of currency in circulation was Ft 12.4 billion higher on the last day of March than at the end of February. The annual growth index of the monetary base (M0)^{a)} was 119.2%.

Net claims of the central bank on the central government increased by Ft 165.9 billion. Assets and liabilities vis-à-vis the sector were Ft 17.9 billion and Ft 183.8 billion lower respectively relative to February. Net assets of the central bank vis-à-vis the rest of the world fell by Ft 131.9 billion. Total assets were Ft 91.7 billion lower, liabilities being Ft 40.2 billion higher, relative to the preceding month.

Net liabilities of the central bank to other monetary financial institutions fell by Ft 83 billion in March. Assets were Ft 0.9 billion lower than in the preceding month. Other monetary financial institutions placed Ft 83.9 billion less domestic and foreign currency deposits with the central bank. Within liabilities to other monetary financial institutions, forint deposits saw the largest change, falling by Ft 147.8 billion. Holdings on current accounts, which include required reserves, increased by Ft 65.3 billion. Foreign currency liabilities fell by Ft 1.5 billion in one month. The increase in other monetary financial institutions' holdings of MNB domestic bills amounted to Ft 0.2 billion.

In March, the averages of central bank liabilities to other monetary financial institutions changed as follows: that of forint deposits fell by Ft 304.2 billion, that of current account holdings rose by Ft 10.8 billion and that of foreign currency liabilities fell by Ft 7.3 billion relative to February. The average amount of MNB domestic bills held by other monetary financial institutions was Ft 0.3 billion higher in comparison with the preceding month.

^{a)} The constituents of M0 are the monthly average stocks of currency in circulation, and other monetary financial institutions' current account balances and overnight deposits with the central bank.
