

Description and technical parameters of the '150 éve alakultak meg a területi ügyvédi kamarák' collector coins

In order to promote the role of these collector coins to transfer value and educate as widely as possible, the silver coin '150 éve alakultak meg a területi ügyvédi kamarák' will be available for purchase for three months, while stocks last, and the non-ferrous metal version for one year from the date of issuance, at face value in the webshop (<https://www.penzvero.hu/>) and coin shop of the Hungarian Mint Ltd. (Budapest, distr. V, 7 Báthory street), starting from 25 April 2025.

The **obverse of the coin** features a depiction of the stained glass that decorates the Budapest Bar Association's headquarters, with the section mark, a symbol of legality and the law itself, in the foreground. Around it, 20 motifs containing a section mark each, reference Hungary's regional lawyers' associations. In a semi-circular legend along the edge of the obverse are the compulsory design elements of collector coins: the inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' (HUNGARY), the denomination '20000' or '3000', the inscription 'FORINT', the mint year '2023' and the mint mark 'BP'. To the right below the depiction of the stained glass is the designer's mark of Balázs Bitó industrial artist, designer of the obverse.

The **reverse of the coin** contains the detail of a press stamp certifying the lawyer's countersignature and legal compliance. The entire side of the coin is to be taken as the impression made by the press stamp; it simultaneously references the jubilee year and features the motto of the legal profession. In a circular legend along the edge of the coin at the top is the inscription 'ÜGYVÉDI KAMARÁK' (LAWYERS' ASSOCIATIONS), and below the lettering 'JOGKERESŐK SZOLGÁLTALÁBAN' (AT THE SERVICE OF SEEKERS OF LEGAL ADVICE) is seen. Between the two semi-circular legends the master mark of applied artist Andrea Horváth, the designer of the reverse, is placed.

Both collector coins are 38.61 mm in diameter, their edges are reeded. There are 150 reeds on the coin's edges, which reinforces the reference to the anniversary year. The silver coin with a face value of 20,000 forints is struck in 925‰ fine silver and weighs 31.46 grams. The non-ferrous metal coin with a face value of 3,000 forint is produced from an alloy of copper (75%) and nickel (25%) and weighs 30.80 grams. 5,000 pieces can be made of the silver collector coin in proof finish and also 5,000 pieces of the non-ferrous version in BU finish.
