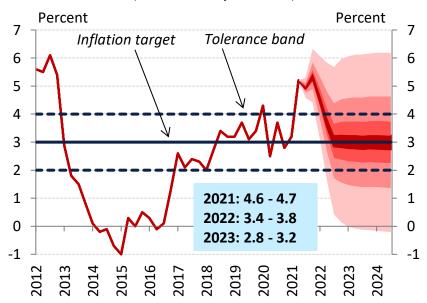
## Baseline inflation and GDP projection of the September 2021 Inflation Report

Looking ahead, the economic outlook has become more uncertain than before as a result of the appearance of the fourth wave of the coronavirus pandemic. Due to the situation that evolved we prepared a forecast showing ranges. When determining the bands, we took decision-makers' risk perception and the volatility recorded in previous years into account. The projections are based on information available for the period ending **16 September 2021**. Our forecast was based on **assumption of endogenous monetary policy**.

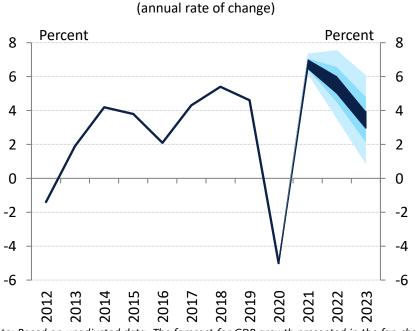


## Inflation projection fan chart
