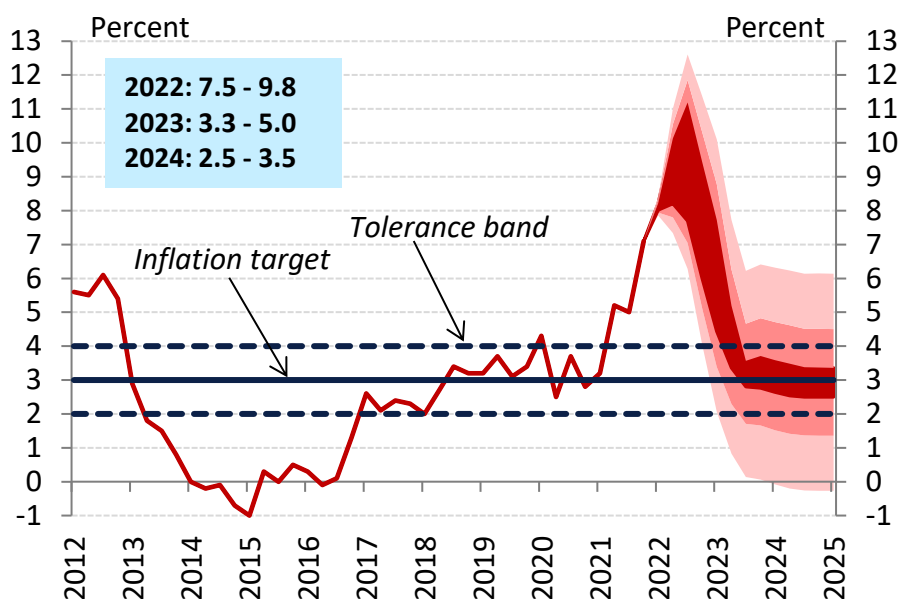


Baseline inflation and GDP projection of the March 2022 Inflation Report

The Russian-Ukrainian War and the consequent sanctions policies that have been introduced as well as the newer wave of the coronavirus epidemic cause significantly more uncertainty in macroeconomic outlook than usual. Due to this situation, we prepared forecast ranges. We took decision-makers' risk perception and the volatility of macroeconomic time series into account when determining the bands. The projections are based on information available for the period ending **17 March 2022**. Our forecast was based on **assumption of endogenous monetary policy**.

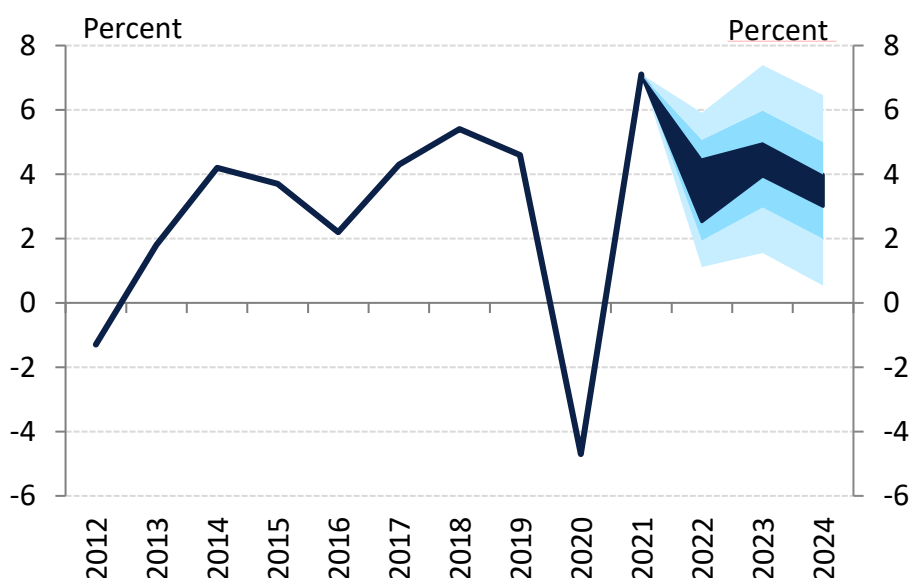
