

## Description and technical parameters 'Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén vármegye, Miskolc' collector coin

The silver version of the 'Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén vármegye, Miskolc' collector coin will be available for purchase (at higher than face value plus VAT) while stock last, and the non-ferrous metal version will be available for purchase for one year at face value at the coin shop of Hungarian Mint Ltd. (Budapest, distr. V, 7 Báthory street) and in its online store (<https://penzvero.hu/>).

**The Mint will start selling the collector coins on June 29, 2026.**

**On the obverse**, in the center of the collector coin the Miskolc-Avas Reformed Church is displayed with the grave monuments of the Avas reformed cemetery around, and with the Avas TV tower in the background. To the left of the depiction mint year '2026', to the right in three horizontal lines, the denomination '30000' or '6000', the wording 'FORINT' and the mint mark 'BP.' are visible. The inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' (HUNGARY) is positioned on the upper right side of the obverse, along the circular arc, while at the bottom, the inscription 'MISKOLC' is written. The master mark of the designer Gábor Kereszthury is on the left, hidden in the depiction.

**On the reverse** the topographic and hydrographic features of Borsod-Abaúj-Zemplén County are displayed, on the left side the Bükk mountains and its plateaus, in the center the hills of Cserehát and on the right side the Zemplén-mountains are visible. In the background is the mountain range of Tatra, and in the foreground is the confluence of rivers Sajó and Hernád in the plains. The depiction is complemented by a relief map of the county on the left, bordered by rivers, with the city of Miskolc

marked with a dot. On the edge of the reverse, in the top center, in three lines, the inscription 'BORSOD-ABAÚJ-ZEMPLÉN VÁRMEGYE' (BORSOD-ABAÚJ-ZEMPLÉN COUNTY) can be read.

Both collector coins are 42 mms in diameter with a finely reeded edge. The pieces in the series are linked by the inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG VÁRMEGYÉI, VÁRMEGYESZÉKHELYEI' (HUNGARIAN COUNTIES AND COUNTY SEATS) appearing twice on the finely reeded edges separated by a hyphen.

The silver coin with a face value of 30,000 forints is struck in .925 fine silver and weighs 40 grams. The non-ferrous metal coin with a face value of 6,000 forints is produced from an alloy of copper (90%) and zinc (10%) and weighs 29.50 grams. 5,000 pieces can be produced of the silver collector coin in proof finish and 6,000 pieces of the non-ferrous version in tarnished finish.
