

## Description and technical parameters of the „Hungarian Football Federation” collector coin

The silver version of the ‘Hungarian Football Federation’ coin will be available for purchase (at higher than face value plus VAT) while stocks last, and the non-ferrous metal version will be available for purchase for one year from the date of issuance of 11 May 2026 at face value at the coin shop of Magyar Pénzverő Zrt. (V. ker. Budapest, Báthory u. 7.) and in its online store (<https://penzvero.hu/>).

The **obverse of the coin** depicts the trophy of the Hungarian cup competition that was launched by the Hungarian Football Federation in 1909, with a detail of the Puskás Aréna in the background. On the edge of the obverse reads ‘MAGYARORSZÁG’ (HUNGARY), to the left of the depiction of the trophy in two horizontal lines, the denominations ‘25000’ and ‘5000’ and the inscription ‘FORINT’ is shown. Below – hidden in the depiction of the Puskás Aréna – the mint year ‘2026’ and the mint mark ‘BP.’ can be read.

The **reverse of the coin** – filling the entire reverse – depicts a laced football used nearly 100 years ago, with the anniversary logo of the Hungarian Football Federation. At the bottom of the reverse edge, the master mark the coin’s designer, applied artist Andrea Horváth can be seen.

Both collector coins are 38.61 mm in diameter, with reeded edges. The silver coin with a face value of 25,000 forints is struck in 925‰ fine silver and weighs 31.46 grams. The non-ferrous metal version with a face value of 5,000 forints is produced from an alloy of copper (75%) and nickel (25%) and weighs 30.80 grams. The mintage limit of the silver coins is 4,000 pieces in proof finish, while that of the non-ferrous coins is 5,000 pieces in BU finish.
