

Description and technical parameters 'The Széchenyi Mansion in Nagycenk' collector coin

The silver version of the 'The Széchenyi Mansion in Nagycenk' coin will be available for purchase (at higher than face value plus VAT) while stock last, and the non-ferrous metal version will be available for purchase for one year from the date of issuance of 11 May 2026 at face value at the coin shop of Magyar Pénzverő Zrt. (V. ker. Budapest, Báthory u. 7.) and in its online store (<https://penzvero.hu/>).

The **obverse of the coin** depicts the joint coat-of-arms of Count Antal Széchenyi and Zsuzsanna Barkóczy, which can be found on the facade of the Széchenyi Mansion in Nagycenk. The Latin motto of the family – 'SI DEUS PRO NOBIS QUIS CONTRA NOS?' ('If God is for us, who can be against us?') – is written in the raised horizontal band below the depiction. At the bottom of the obverse, the inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' (HUNGARY) is written, above it, in two horizontal lines, the denomination '5000', the wording 'FORINT', the mint mark 'BP.' and the mint year '2026' is featured.

The **reverse of the coin** shows a distant view of the Széchenyi Mansion, with the Baroque-style front garden, that is part of the Fertő/Neusiedlersee Cultural Landscape World Heritage Site in the foreground. The circular legend in the outer ring borderd by an outline the words 'NAGYCENK • SZÉCHENYI-KASTÉLY MŰEMLÉKI EGYÜTTESE' (NAGYCENK • THE SZÉCHENYI MANSION) can be read, with the legend 'NEMZETI EMLÉKHELY' (NATIONAL MEMORIAL SITE) below. The inscriptions are separated from each other by the collective logo of the national memorial sites on the left, and by the master mark of the designer Ferenc Lebó on the right.

The circular non-ferrous metal coin from an alloy of copper (90%) and zinc (10%). It weighs 18.4 grams; it is 37 mms in diameter with a reeded edge. 10,000 pieces can be made of the collector coin in a bronze-coated finish.

The collector coin is the 13th addition to the series presenting national memorial sites in Hungary.
