

Description and technical parameters of the “500th Anniversary of the Battle of Mohács” collector coins

The silver version of the “500th anniversary of the Battle of Mohács” coin will be available for purchase (at higher than face value plus VAT) while stocks last, and the non-ferrous metal version will be available for purchase for one year from the date of issuance of 28 August 2026 at face value at the coin shop of Magyar Pénzverő Zrt. (V. ker. Budapest, Báthory u. 7.) and in its online store (<https://penzvero.hu/>).

The **obverse of the coin** features a composition evoking the split gate of the Mohács National Memorial Site and a stylized depiction of a burial mound – adorned with cross-shaped motifs and split in two by a sword – bearing the inscription of the concluding lines of Károly Kisfaludy’s 1821 poem Mohács: “...A MULT CSAK PÉLDA LEGYEN MOST, S ÉGVE HONÉRT BIZTON NÉZZEN ELŐRE SZEMÜNK, ÉS TE VIRULJ, GYÁSZTÉR! A BÉKE MALASZTOS ÖLÉBEN, NEMZETI NAGYLÉTÜNK HAJDANI SIRJA MOHÁCS!” (...LET THE PAST BE A LESSON NOW ONLY, AND WITH OUR HEARTS BURNING FOR THE HOMELAND LET OUR EYES LOOK FORWARD WITH CONFIDENCE, AND MAY YOU FLOURISH, FIELD OF MOURNING, IN THE GRACIOUS LAP OF PEACE, MOHÁCS, THE FORMER GRAVE OF OUR NATION'S GRAND EXISTENCE!), with a depiction of a pile of weaponry beneath it. Along the rim of the obverse, the inscription “MAGYARORSZÁG” (HUNGARY) appears at the top, the minting year “2026” on the left, and the mint mark “BP.” on the right.

The **reverse of the coin** depicts horsemen symbolizing the warriors of Hungary and other European countries heading into battle; facing them is a line of spears—tracing a crescent shape and featuring motifs of crescents and horse-tail standards that symbolize the Ottoman army. Along the left edge of the reverse, the "Mohács 500" logo appears at the top, while at the bottom—positioned between two opposing spear motifs and a horizontal line—are the denominations "30000" and "6000" and the inscription "forint". The master mark of Zoltán Endrődy, the coin's designer, appears on the left side, beneath the depiction of the mounted army.

Non-ferrous metal collector coin

The collector coins are rectangular in landscape format, measuring 26.40 × 39.60 mm, with a smooth edge. The silver coin with a face value of 30,000 forints is struck in 925‰ fine silver and weighs 31.46 grams. The non-ferrous metal version with a face value of 6,000 forints is produced from an alloy of copper (75%) and nickel (25%) and weighs 27 grams. The mintage limit of both coins is 5,000 pieces. The silver coin is produced in proof finish and the non-ferrous metal coin in BU finish.
