

## Description and technical parameters of the 'Hungarian Chamber of Commerce and Industry' collector coin

The collector coin of the 'Hungarian Chamber of Commerce and Industry' will be available for purchase for one year from the date of issuance of 27 May 2026 at face value at the coin shop of Magyar Pénzverő Zrt. (V. ker. Budapest, Báthory u. 7.) and in its online store (<https://penzvero.hu/>).

On the **obverse of the coin**, in the central field with a bright base bordered by an outline, the coat of arms of Hungary is depicted. The inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' (HUNGARY) is visible in a circular form above, protruding from the radially notched plane of the circular ring visible on the edge of the obverse, on the right is the year of mintage '2026', below is the value indication '5000' and the inscription 'FORINT', and on the left is the mint mark 'BP.'

On the **reverse of the coin**, in the central field bordered by an outline, a stylized relief map depicting the Carpathian Basin and its surroundings, as well as the current national borders, can be seen. Next to three of the 11 founding cities of the Chamber marked with dots on the map - given their special significance - their names at the time of their foundation can be read: 'SOPRON', 'PEST-BUDA' and 'DEBRECEN'. On the right side of the central field - inserted into the map representation - the master's mark of the designer Balázs Bitó can be seen. On the edge of the reverse, protruding from the radially notched plane of the ring, the inscription 'MAGYAR KERESKEDELMI ÉS IPARKAMARA' (HUNGARIAN CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND INDUSTRY) can be read in the upper semicircle, and 'ALAPÍTVÁ 1850' (ESTABLISHED 1850) in the lower semicircle.

The collector coin is 38.61 mm in diameter, with reeded edge. The collector coin is produced from an alloy of copper (75%) and nickel (25%), and its weight is 30.80 grams. The mintage limit of the coin is 6,000 pieces.
