

Description and technical parameters of the 'Kuvasz' collector coin

In order to promote the role of these collector coins to transfer value and educate as widely as possible, the 'Kuvasz' coin will be available for purchase for one year, while stock last, from the date of issuance of 4 October 2025 at face value at the coin shop of Magyar Pénzverő Zrt. (V. ker. Budapest, Báthory u. 7.) and in its online store (<https://www.penzvero.hu/>) beginning from 6 October 2025.

The **obverse of the coin** features a full-length, side-view depiction of a kuvasz. The edge of the obverse displays, in circular lettering, at the top and on the left, the inscription 'MAGYARORSZÁG' (HUNGARY), the denomination '3000' and the inscription 'FORINT'. Arranged in two horizontal lines under the depiction of the kuvasz are the year of minting '2025' and the 'BP.' mint mark.

The **reverse of the coin** features a half-length depiction of two kuvasz dogs in a grassy steppe environment with two Hungarian grey cattle in the background. The upper left side of the reverse displays, in circular lettering, the inscription 'KUVASZ'. Below, in the middle, inserted into the depiction of the grassy steppe, is designer Zoltán Tóth's master mark.

The non-ferrous metal collector coin is minted from an alloy of copper (75%), nickel (4%) and zinc (21%). It weighs 16 grams and it is 34 mm in diameter and has a reeded edge. The collector coins are issued in limited quantities: a total of 20,000 coins will be produced in proof-like finish.
